COPPER MOUNTAIN FOUNDATION YOUTH GRANT PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY: Open to original enrollees of The Tatitlek Corporation (TTC) and lineal descendants of original enrollees (by birth or adoption). The Copper Mountain Foundation provides grants to promote Tatitlek Corporation shareholder or descendant youth participation in programs which promote education or preservation of Tatitlek Native culture and traditions, art, history and language.

AMOUNT: Grant awards may be up to \$1,000 per program per year. Grants larger than \$1000 will require board approval. Payment will be made directly to the school or program providing the youth activities or supplies and cannot be made directly to any student or parent. Reimbursement of program expenses is not permitted.

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Attachment A: Personal Statement Guidelines

1. Introduction:
